# ORIENTATION

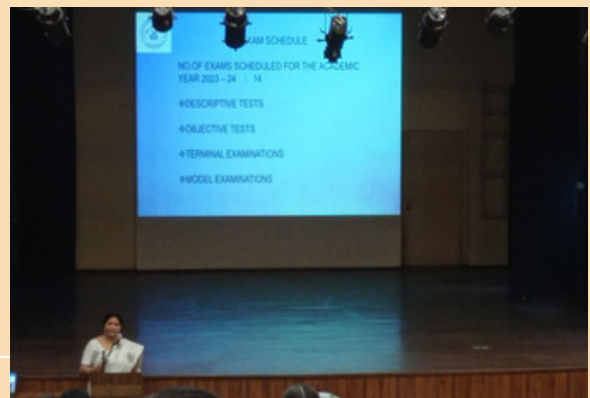
## Std XI

ChatGPT is a free communication tool created by the OpenAI team. Essentially, ChatGPT is an AI \*chatbot\* (browser-based chat software) that uses deep learning to generate strings of text in response to a user query. It is designed to respond to general and technical questions.

ChatGPT was initially built on a family of large language models (LLMs) collectively known as GPT-3. These models can understand and generate human-like answers to text prompts, because they've been trained on huge amounts of data.

OpenAI has now announced that its next-gen GPT-4 models are available

2. Limits creativity : Every writer brings a unique perspective and voice to their work. If everyone used ChatGPT to write their essays, online content, or emails, there won't be any nuance or uniqueness to anything anymore.

3. Plagiarism : ChatGPT is not a full suite of writing tools. Some AI-generated content might include uncited quotations, or pieces from already-existing work.

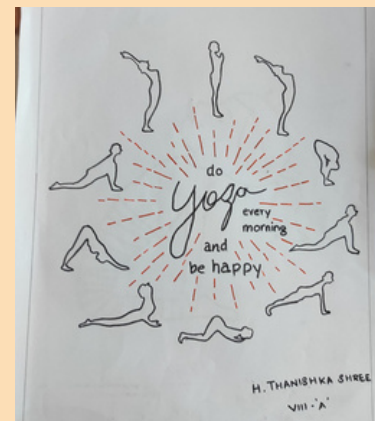

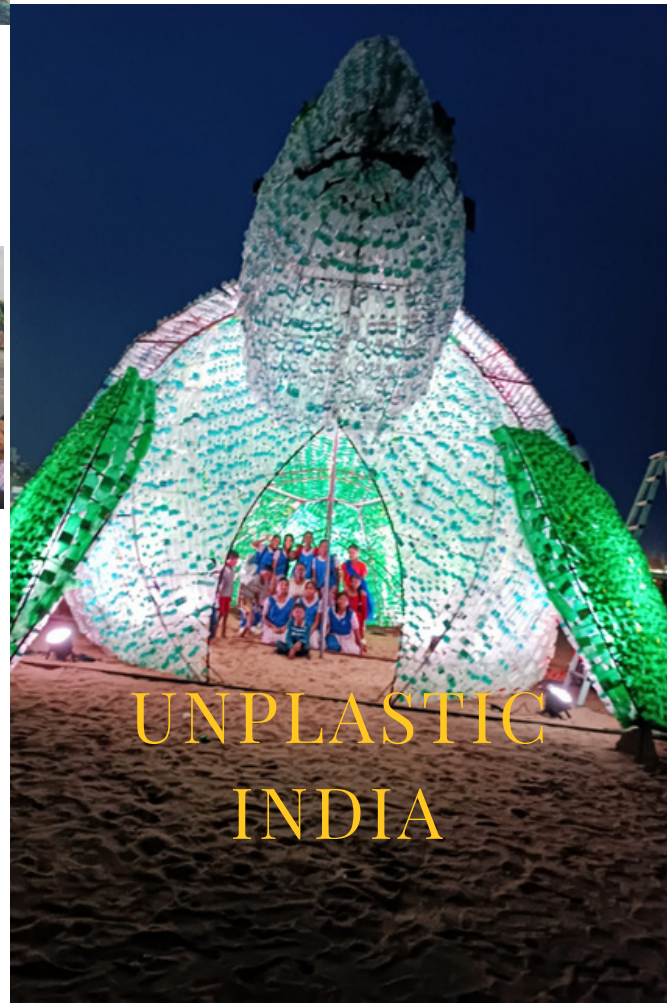
