The Interactors are poised and all set to work for the welfare of the school as well as the community. They are looking forward to creating a more peaceful, selfless and sustainable atmosphere












ABC Can-Stop Exhibition


Online session by the Rotary Club of Madras on 'Peace'

On the 13th of September 2024, out interacters were honored with the opportunity to visit the Adyar Cancer Institute, Chennai, to donate biscuits, soaps, and dates to the patients. Two

Interactors, along with a teacher coordinator, met with Dr. Surendran Veeraiah, Professor and Head of the Department of Psycho-oncology and RCTC.



During the visit, we learned about the causes, stages, and prevention of cancer.

Dr. Surendran emphasized that cancer is curable if detected early. He explained that while only 10% of cancers are linked to genetic factors, the other 90% result from unhealthy lifestyle choices. A balanced diet and regular exercise are crucial in preventing the disease.



Dr. Surendran stressed that early detection plays a vital role in improving the chances of a cure.

We concluded the visit with the powerful message: "Spreading awareness today, for a healthier, cancer-free tomorrow."
