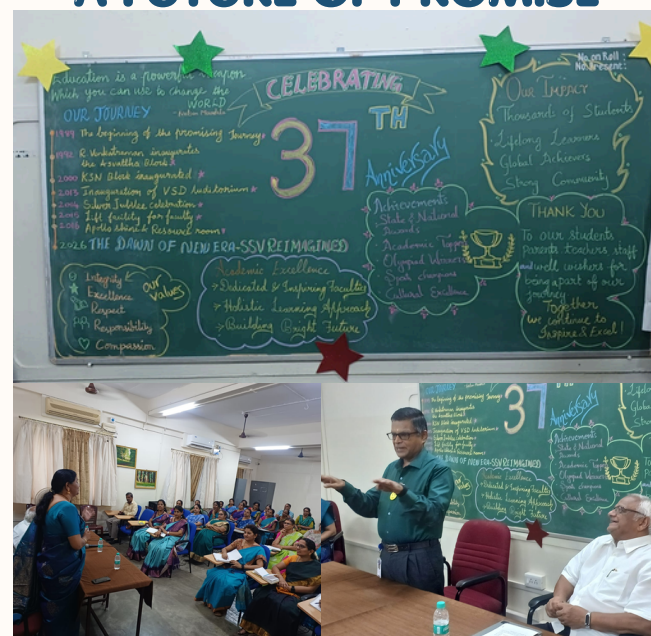

Environmental Day YOUNG HANDS, GREEN HEARTS



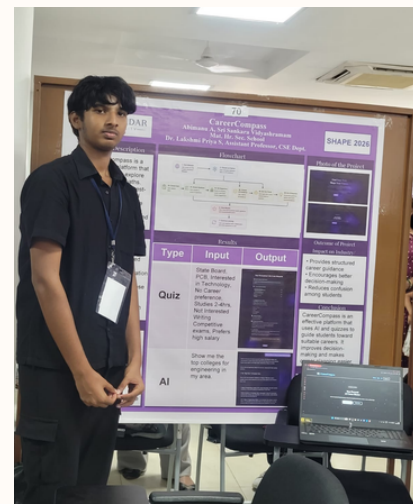
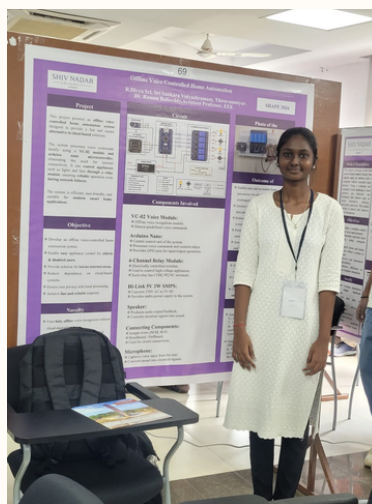
